 Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, has notified the Cinematograph (Certification) Rules, 2024, in supersession of the Cinematograph (Certification) Rules, 1983.

Cinematograph (Certification) Rules, 2024

- Age-Based Certification: Introduction of age based categories of certification by further sub-dividing the existing UA category into three age-based categories, viz. seven years (UA 7+), thirteen years (UA 13+), and sixteen years (UA 16+), instead of twelve years.
- Greater representation of women in the CBFC Board & CBFC's Advisory Panels, where it is stipulated that onethird of the members in the Board shall be women and preferably half shall be women.
- **System for Priority Screening** of Films for enhancing transparency and eliminating all discretions.

About

 The Model Code of Conduct comes into effect. immediately after the announcement of the poll dates and remains effective until the announcement of results.

What is the Model Code of Conduct (MCC)?

- It is a **set of guidelines/norms** for political parties and candidates, issued by the Election Commission, to create a "level playing field".
- It aims to avert practices that are deemed corrupt under the model code such as politicians making hate speeches or promises about new projects that may sway voters.
- The MCC is **not enforceable by law**. However, certain provisions of the MCC may be enforced through invoking corresponding provisions in other statutes such as the Indian Penal Code, 1860, Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, and Representation of the People Act, 1951.

Express View on Bengaluru's looming water crisis: The warning

Bengaluru's woes are a crisis foretold. Other Indian cities must learn lessons from it



News

• Bengaluru is facing **its worst drought** in 30-40 years, leading to an acute water shortage.

Bengaluru's Water Crisis

- Bengaluru experienced a rainfall deficit in 2023 led to declining groundwater levels.
- Historically, Bengaluru relied on a network of lakes and tanks for water supply. However, rapid urbanization has led to the encroachment and drying out of these water bodies.
- The Arkavathi Reservoir, once a vital water source, is severely depleted and polluted due to uncontrolled development and encroachments.

Water stress in India

- India has 18 percent of the world's population, but only 4
 percent of its water resources, making it among the most
 water-stressed in the world.
- A NITI Aayog report, 'Composite Water Management Index' (2018) has said that India is facing its 'worst' water crisis in history, with more than 600 million people facing acute water shortages.

Why has India developed an atmospheric testbed near Bhopal?





News

 The first phase of India's Atmospheric Research Testbed in Central India (ART-CI) was inaugurated at Silkheda in Madhya Pradesh.

What is the Atmospheric Research Testbed (ART)?

- The ART is an open-field, focused observational and analytical research programme.
- It aims to conduct ground-based observations of weather parameters like temperature, wind speeds, etc. and in-situ (on-site) observations of the transient synoptic systems – like low-pressure areas and depressions that form in the Bay of Bengal – during the southwest monsoon season.

Application

- Studying these systems and their associated cloud parameters will be used to generate high volumes of data over a long period.
- It can then be compared with the existing weather models so that improvements can be made to obtain accurate rainfall predictions.
