• UK signs deal to return Chagos Islands to Mauritius.





#### **Crucial Facts**

- Location: Indian Ocean
- **Territory:** British Indian Ocean Territory
- Major islands: Diego Garcia, Peros Banhos, Salomon Islands, Egmont Islands
- **Dispute:** Claimed by Mauritius, which demands sovereignty.





## **Key Highlights**



- In 1965, UK separated Chagos from Mauritius, forming BIOT overseas territory.
- Indigenous **Chagossians expelled** (1967-1973) for the US military base on **Diego Garcia**.
- ICJ and the International Tribunal ruled that the **UK must return** the islands to Mauritius.
- UK to transfer **Chagos Islands to Mauritius** (agreement signed May 2025).



• UN to probe human rights violations in Afghanistan.






#### **Crucial Facts**

- Capital and largest city: Kabul
- Country: Landlocked country at Central and South Asia crossroads
- totalitarian • Government: Unitary theocratic Islamic emirate
- Borders: India(SE), Pakistan (E/S), Iran (W), Turkmenistan (NW), Uzbekistan (N), Tajikistan (NE), China (NE/E).





## **Key Highlights**



- Afghanistan is known as "graveyard of empires" due to repeated foreign invasions.
- It gained independence after the **Third Anglo-Afghan War in** 1919, ending foreign control.
- Second-largest producer of cannabis resin, major saffron, cashmere production.
- **High poverty, child malnutrition,** and **terrorism** hinder economic development.
