## IIT Kharagpur's new study reveals hidden air pollutant that can decline crop yields

## Context

 Study by IIT Kharagpur highlights that surface ozone pollution is adversely affecting major food crops in Indo-Gangetic Plain and central India.

## **What is Ozone Pollution?**

- Ozone  $(0_3)$  is a gas made of three oxygen atoms.
- Found in two layers of the atmosphere:
  - Stratosphere (upper atmosphere): Beneficial protects from UV rays.
  - Troposphere (ground level): Harmful acts as a pollutant.

#### **Formation of Tropospheric Ozone**

- Not directly emitted.
- Formed by a reaction between:
  - $\circ$  Nitrogen oxides (NO<sub>x</sub>)
  - Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs)
  - Sunlight as a catalyst

#### **Health and Environmental Impact**

- Acts as an air pollutant and greenhouse gas.
- Harmful to human health, vegetation, and crop productivity.

#### **WHO Guidelines**

- Recommends max ozone concentration:
- 100 μg/m³ (8-hour maximum average in a day).







## Industrial production slows, IIP at 6-month low of 2.9% in February 2025

## **Context**

• Index of Industrial Production (IIP) grew at its slowest rate in six months, clocking a pace of 2.9% in February 2025.

## **Index of Industrial Production (IIP)**

- The IIP is an index which shows the growth rates in different industry groups of the economy in a stipulated period of time.
- It is a composite indicator that measures the growth rate of industry groups classified under:
- Broad sectors: Mining, Manufacturing, and Electricity.
- Use-based sectors: Basic Goods, Capital Goods, and Intermediate Goods.
- Released by: The Central Statistical Organisation (CSO), Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation.
- **Base year**: 2011-2012
- Periodicity: Monthly basis







## Atmospheric river storm brought heavy rain, strong winds, and severe thunderstorms across the United States.

## **Context**

 Atmospheric river caused heavy rain, strong winds, and thunderstorms across much of the U.S.

### **Overview**

#### **Definition:**

- Narrow, fast-moving bands of moisture and wind that transport large amounts of water vapor from tropical oceans to land.
- Span 402 to 606 km in width and over 1,600 km in length.

#### **Characteristics:**

- Often resemble hurricanes in intensity.
- Most common in mid-latitudes.
- **Example**: Pineapple Express Carries moisture from Hawaii to U.S. and Canadian West Coasts.
- Recent U.S. storm originated from the Caribbean.

#### **Importance:**

• Most atmospheric rivers are weak and beneficial, providing vital rain and snow.

#### **Threats:**

• Can cause severe weather events like heavy rain, strong winds, flooding, and mudslides.

#### **Future Projections:**

 NASA study predicts atmospheric rivers will become longer, wider, and more intense, increasing the risk of severe flooding.







## Why are ASHA workers protesting in Kerala? | Explained

## **Context**

ASHA workers in Kerala have been protesting for better remuneration and retirement benefits.

## **Overview**

#### **About ASHAs:**

- ASHA stands for Accredited Social Health Activist.
- They are community health workers appointed under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW).
- ASHAs are a key part of the National Rural Health Mission (NRHM), launched in 2005.
- The mission aimed for full implementation by 2012.

#### **Roles and Objectives:**

- Act as a bridge between the community and public health system, especially in rural and marginalized areas.
- Promote awareness and ensure access to health and family welfare services.
- Serve as first responders in areas with limited access to medical care.

#### **Remuneration:**

- ASHA workers earn an average of ₹6,000-₹10,000 per month.
- Earnings include a monthly honorarium from both Central and State governments, plus performance-based incentives.







## **Justice BR Gavai To Be the Next CJI**

## **Context**

 On April 17, 2025, CJI Sanjiv Khanna recommended Justice B.R. Gavai to be the 52nd Chief Justice of India (CJI).


## **Overview**

#### **Constitutional Provisions**

- Article 124(1): Mentions the existence of a Supreme Court with a Chief Justice.
- Article 124(2): Judges, including the CJI, are appointed by the President.
- No specific constitutional procedure for appointing the CJI is mentioned.

#### **Appointment Convention**

- The outgoing CJI recommends the senior-most judge as successor.
- Seniority is based on the date of appointment to the Supreme Court, not age.
- If appointed on the same day:
  - The one sworn in first is considered senior.
  - If both are sworn in together, High Court service length is considered.
  - Judges from the Bench are senior to appointees from the Bar.







## India and International Big Cat Alliance sign agreement to host its headquarters

## **Context**

India signs deal to host IBCA headquarters, boosting global big cat conservation.

## **About**

- India will host the IBCA Headquarters and Secretariat.
- Government will provide ₹150 crore support from 2023–24 to 2028–29.
- Funds will cover infrastructure, recurring costs, and corpus creation to help IBCA meet its goals.

#### **About IBCA:**

- Launched: In 2023 by the PM during Project Tiger's 50th anniversary event at Mysuru.
- **Legal Status**: Became a legal entity after 5 countries (India, Nicaragua, Eswatini, Somalia, Liberia) signed the framework.
- Membership: 27 countries have agreed to join.
- **Goal**: Global conservation of seven big cats Tiger, Lion, Leopard, Snow Leopard, Cheetah, Jaguar, Puma.

#### **Objectives:**

- Promote cooperation among countries.
- Share successful conservation practices.
- Build global expertise to protect big cats.
