India's UNESCO Tentative List Grows To 69 With Seven New Natural Sites

Context

• The seven heritage sites from across India have been included in the UNESCO's Tentative list of World Heritage Sites, raising it to 69.

Context

 The Prime Minister of India launched the campaign during the Rastriya Poshan Maah in Madhya Pradesh.

Overview:

- The initiative is led jointly by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MOHFW) and Ministry of Women and Child Development (MoWCD) for nationwide implementation.
- It aims to provide community-level preventive, promotive and curative healthcare for women.
- It will be implemented through 10 lakh health camps at government healthcare facilities.
- This mission strengthens screening, early detection, and treatment of major women-related health issues.

Significance

- This mission strength screening, early detection and treatment of major women-related health issues.
- It focuses on treatments of -
 - Non-comuunicable diseases
 - Anameia
 - Tuberculosis
 - Sickle cell diseases
- It promotes Mental Health, Child Health and Adolescent.

Astronomers have spotted the biggest bangs since the Big Bang

Context

• Scientists have discovered Extreme Nuclear Transients (ENT)explosion even more powerful than Gamma-Ray Bursts (GRB).

What is GRB?

 It is a highly energetic explosion observed in distant galaxies, among the most powerful events in the universe after the Big Bang.

What are ENTs?

- ENTs phenomena occur when massive stars are torn apart by supermassive black holes at the centres of distant galaxies.
- These events release energy equivalent to 100 Suns over their lifetimes.
- They are visible across vast cosmic distances and remains **luminous** in radio wavelengths for year.

Significance of ENTs

- It helps scientists study supermassive black holes and galactic evolutions.
- It offers insights into the early universe.

Nightmare Bacteria: What it is and why US cases are surging

Context

• American Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) report: infections from drug-registance "nightmare bacteria" rose by 70% from 2019 to 2023.

What is 'Nightmare Bacteria'?

- It refers mainly to Carbapenem-Resistance Enterobacteriaceae (CRE).
- It includes a bacteria named- Escherichia coli (E.coli) and klebsiella pneumonia.
- It is called "nightmare" because they are resistant to carbapenems- antibodies used as a last resort.

Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR)

- It occurs when bacteria/fungi resist drugs meant to kill them.
- It makes infections harder to treat, increasing illness, death and the healthcare costs.

NDM Gene-Key causes

- It rises in cases linked to bacteria carrying the NDM gene (New Delhi metallo- βlactamse).
- NDM gene enables bacteria to neutralise multiple antibiotics, including carbapenems
- It is originally detected in India, now spreading globally.

Why it Matters

- It leads to treatment failure in critical infections.
- It increases risk of the outbreaks in hospitals.
- A major global health threat needing urgent global actions.

UPI now accepted in Qatar, Qatar Duty Free becomes first merchant

Context

• National Payment Council of India (NPCI) International partnered with Qatar National Bank to enable UPI QR code payments in Qatar.

What is UPI?

- Unified Payments Interface (UPI) is a real-time, instant digital payment system.
- It was developed by the National Payment Corporation of India (NPCI) in 2016.

How does it works?

- It operates on Immediate Payment Services (IMPS) infrastructure.
- It allows linking of multiple bank accounts in one app (e.g. Google Pay, Phone Pay, PhonePe, Paytm, Bhim).
- It enables 24*7 instant fund transfers using mobile phones.

Global Recognition

- World's largest real-time payment system.
- In 2024, UPI processed over 12 billion transactions monthly, covering 65% of India's retail digital payments.

• UAE, Nepal Bhutan France, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Mauritius and Now Qatar.
