

Ramsar Convention (COP 15)

Why in News?


• Ramsar COP15 concluded in Zimbabwe with resolutions on restoration, species protection, equitable governance.

Overview

- Location: Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe
- Theme: "Protecting Wetlands for Our Common Future"
- Next Host: Panama (COP16 in 2028)

Major Outcome

- All 13 resolutions adopted covering wetland protection, monitoring capacity building and climate adaptation.
- Victoria Falls Declaration which emphasized political will, funding and sustainable wetland management.
- Commitment Made to restore degraded freshwater ecosystems and protect migratory birds.
- Improved criteria for designating wetlands of International importance.
- Strategic Plan approved with 4 goals and 18 targets for global wetland conservation.







AGNISHODH

Why in News?

• The Indian Army and IIT Madras have jointly established the 'Agnishodh' Research cell.

About the Agnishodh

- It is a joint initiative of the Indian Army and IIT Madras.
- It established the Indian Army research cell (IARC) at IIT Madras campus.

Purpose and Vision

- Part of Indian Army's transformation framework guided by Five Pillars of Transformation.
- It focuses on modernisation and technology infusion, a key pillar of the transformation.

Upskilling Military Personnel

- Trains in emerging tech domains like:
 - Additive Manufacturing, Cybersecurity, Quantum Computing, Wireless Communication, Unmanned Aerial Systems.







NYAYA BANDHU LEGAL AID PROGRAMME

Why in News?

• Nyaya Bandhu provides free legal aid via app, connecting advocates and eligible beneficiaries.

Overview

- It was launched in 2017 under the scheme DISHA (Designing Innovative Solutions for Holistic Access to Justice).
- Implemented by the Department of Justice, Ministry of Law and Justice.
- Till June 2025, about 14,888 women beneficiaries have registered via the Nyaya Bandhu App.

Objective

- It provides free legal assistance to eligible beneficiaries.
- It creates a structured framework for Pro Bono (voluntary) legal services by advocates.

Key Features

- Registration of Advocates and Beneficiaries:
 - Pro Bono advocates register on the Nyaya Bandhu Mobile App.
 - o Beneficiaries also register to connect with advocates.
- Nyaya Bandhu Mobile Application:
 - o Digital platform matching Pro Bono lawyers with applicants.
 - o Ensures transparency, accessibility, and efficiency.
- Pro Bono Clubs (PBCs):
 - Set up in law schools across India.
 - o Engage law students in community legal care and awareness, especially in rural and remote areas.
